



Schools agree to:

Reinforce the safety rules for students on buses.

Ensure students understand that poor behaviour at any time on or in the vicinity of buses may lead to death or serious injury to themselves or others.

Take appropriate measures to deal with any poor behaviour and work with the operator, Education Department, Environment Department and parents/guardians in the event of problems.

Agree contingency plans with operators in the event of bad weather or other emergencies.

Provide adequate supervision at school set-down and pick-up points.

Liaise with the operator concerning any special pick-up arrangements at the school.

Liaise with the operator if there is any change in requirements.

Consult with the Environment Department and the operator at an early stage when considering change to school attendance times.

For safety reasons, to minimise interaction between parents' cars and school bus operations.

Inform the Environment Department when a service does not comply with the timetable or does not run.
